**Job Description:** Assess patients' oral health problems and needs while providing oral hygiene care. Hygienists will also advise patients on proper maintenance and prevention practices.

## What does a Dental Hygienist do?

- Examine patients gums visually and with tools for signs of disease
- Chart conditions of decay and disease for treatment by dentist
- Record and review patients' medical histories
- Expose and develop x-rays
- Apply fluorides or other agents to prevent cavities and limit decay
- Maintain dental equipment and sharpen and sterilize dental instruments
- Administer local anesthetics to patients
- Feel lymph nodes to check for swelling or other signs of oral cancer
- Assist in conducting dental health clinics for community groups
- Provide services or health education to the general public
