

## Tax Consultant

**Job Description:** Prepares tax returns for individuals or small businesses. What does a Tax Consultant do? Use all appropriate adjustments, deductions, and credits to keep clients' taxes to a minimum Compute taxes owed or overpaid, using adding machines or personal computers Complete tax forms, following tax form instructions and tax tables Obtain information on taxable income and deductible expenses and allowances Review financial records, such as income statements and documentation of expenditures to determine forms needed to prepare tax returns Check data input or verify totals on forms prepared by others to detect errors in arithmetic, data entry, or procedures Provide taxpayers with sufficient information and advice to ensure correct tax form completion Your Interests: **Outlook:** Do you like math?
