Job Description: Distribute medications prescribed by health practitioners and provide information to patients about their use. May advise practitioners and patients on selection, dosage, and side effects of medications.

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What does a Pharmacist do?

- Review prescriptions and provide information regarding drug interactions, side effects, dosage, and proper medication storage
- Monitor patient compliance and prevent excessive usage or harmful side effects
- Evaluate the quality and effectiveness of drugs or drug regimens, providing advice on drug applications or characteristics
- Maintain procedures for mixing, packaging, or labeling of medications to ensure security and proper disposal
- Mix and dispense prescribed medications by calculating, weighing, measuring, and mixing ingredients
- Publish educational information for other pharmacists, practitioners, and patients
